School Supply list

Grades Kindergarten - 6**

Kindergarten

When possible, please purchase the brands we recommend. After many years of teaching this age of students we know which brands work the best, last the longest, and are easiest for the children to use. You will find school supplies on sale mid-July and early August.

- (4) boxes of 8-count Crayola brand crayons
- (1) box of Crayola classic colors wide markers (8 or 10 count)
- (1) box of Crayola classic colors fine line (thin) (8 to 10 count)
- (2) 4 oz. bottles of white school glue
- (1) package of pencils (approximately a dozen), please no fancy erasers or attachments
- (1) large box of Kleenex or facial tissue
- (1) box zipper-lock clear freezer storage bags (boys bring sandwich size, girls bring gallon size)

Please do not label these school supplies. They will be part of our community classroom supplies.

Your child will also need: a large backpack (no wheels), a resting mat or rug, a paint shirt (an adult T shirt works great), a recent photo of the student, and shoes for phy-ed. The ideal shoes for a kindergarten student are shoes the child can get into and out of independently (Velcro is fine).

2 glue sticks (large if possible)
1 4oz. bottle of glue
2 yellow highlighters
1 box Kleenex (2 boxes for Goldsmith)
Flash cards - multiplication and division
Mrs. Goldsmith only - one 3-ring binder and one package of clear page protectors

Music - grade 4 - one pocket folder and 2 sharpened pencils.

24 pencils - sharpened if possible

Sturdy zippered pencil pouch (not plastic)

Red pens (3)

Highlighters - multiple colors

2 black sharpie markers , 1 fine point, 1 extra fine point

10 spiral notebooks - 2-red, 2 yellow, 2 green, 2 blue, 2 purple

20 pocket folders - 4 red, 4yellow, 4 green, 4 blue, 4 purple
